



Picnic by a convict-built cottage, circa 1836. Henry Kendall Cottage and Historical Museum is a peaceful spot set on two and a half acres, offering a rare glimpse into an early settler past. It was once home to the famous Australian poet of the same name, from 1873-74.
Classic pub lunch at Hotel Gosford, a venue reimagined with its sleek interior and open air appeal, serving daily from its dedicated dining space, Earl's Kitchen.
House-made pastries and decadent sweet treats at Bouffant. With its "fluffy goodness for everyone" tagline, this grab-and-go spot is a petite, pink bakery café with a daily line-up of Insta-worthy treats.
Chocolate factory tours and junior chocolatier workshops. Stop by The Factory for a chocolate and nougat fix with a wide range of delectable treats. Go behind-the-scenes on a tour, or for the kids – a junior chocolatier workshop.
Feed the koi and catch an exhibition at Gosford Regional Gallery. Capture a moment of zen in the Japanese-themed Edogawa Commemorative Garden, and fun-filled immersive workshops await in the adjoining gallery throughout the year.
Café-crawl. There are a growing number of coffee houses and casual-cool dining venues popping up across the CBD's heart, with coffee-lovers and diners now spoilt for choice.
Cheer-on a game at Central Coast Stadium. Hosting a number of national sporting matches across codes, concerts and events throughout the year. Be sure to catch a home game for the mighty Central Coast Mariners.
Enjoy a craft beer at Bay Road Brewing. A microbrewery in the heart of Gosford, enjoy a beer made in-house alongside a tasty feed from the rotation of food vendors.
Book a class to learn something new. Sign up for a craft workshop at Albert's Line, or test your culinary skills in a class at Julie's Place with Australia's first MasterChef, Julie Goodwin.
Hike Rumbalara Reserve. Behind Gosford is this leafy reserve with its multiple walking tracks and viewing platform with a panorama across Brisbane Water.
Sail and a sunset sip. The Gosford Sailing Club is a top spot, with its impressive location on the water for a relaxed meal and drink after a day's sailing.
