PERFORMERS



Kutcha Edwards

Kutcha Edwards has been prolifically combining song writing and activism since 1991, when he joined Koori group Watbalimba and began the remarkable journey that has taken him from the tiny Riverina town of Balranald to tours of Australia and the world.

It is his experiences as a survivor of the Stolen Generations and his proud Mutti Mutti heritage that has shaped his diverse creative output in groups like Blackfire and The Black Arm Band. At the same time, he's also been able to forge a successful solo career combining his 'Bidgee' blues with traditional songs of people and country.



Paco Lara

Francisco Lara Puerto, better known as Paco Lara is an acclaimed flamenco guitarist from the birthplace and cradle of flamenco Jerez de la Frontera, in Spain. Paco started playing guitar at a very young age, when he was only 8 years old.

At a still tender age of 16, Paco began working professionally as a flamenco guitarist with one of his brother's singer José Lara, recording 2 albums and touring extensively. Later, Paco was also mentor and promoter of his other brother, Santiago Lara, who won the renowned La Bienal de Flamenco de Sevilla (2000), Spain's most prestigious guitar competition.





Band Ombe

Band OMBE, is essentially an Afro-Uruguayan "Candombe" Band, born in Australia with strong influences in Jazz, Blues, Rock and other "Latino" rhythms. A high energy show which boasts 3 singers, a dancer, brass section all held together by a grooving rhythm section at its heart, the essence of Candombe.



Magdalena Mira Band

One of the highlights of the event is Magdalena Mira band!! Led by local Ettalong songstress Magdalena Mira a captivating and engaging performer with a voice and a presence that lingers long after she's left the stage.

She has lived in Australia for the past 14 years where she has focused on her love of Latin and Jazz music. She has the unique ability to absorb and express music from her culture as well as others, creating a very interesting hybrid.

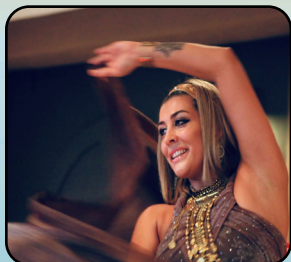
EnCLOWNter
