- **Take a Heritage Tour.** Take a self-guided Wyong Heritage Walk available around the town centre, with signposted stops to help you step back into the shoes of locals in the 19th century.
- **The Wyong Milk Factory experience.** Standing since 1906, the site has been lovingly restored to house a modern mix of local makers, creators and producers. Shop locally produced cheese, chocolates and doughnuts!
- **Spot a Platypus paddling Wyong Creek.** Hire a kayak from All Sorts Fitness and paddle down Wyong Creek for a little adventure. While paddling, you will spot various wildlife, but most notably you may spy a wild Platypus!
- **Freshly roasted coffee and laneway lunching.** Wyong's centre is a great spot for grabbing your morning pick-me-up, casual business meeting, or al fresco brunch spilling out onto the manicured green lawn. Behind the Historic Chapman Building, you will find Chapman Coffee House.
- **Shop the Chapman Building.** Discover the beautifully curated gifts and homewares of Scout and Trader, boutique browse at Lovinn' Lime and book a creative workshop at the House of Ellery
- **World class entertainment at The Art House.** A modern live performing arts, music and comedy venue on the Central Coast, making world-class theatre inclusive and accessible to the local community.
- **Relaxing day on the green.** Test your skills with a round of golf at one of the Top 100 Courses in Australia (Australian Golfing Digest) – Kooindah Waters Golf Club, fondly known as 'the thinking golfer's course'.
- **Heart thumping day at the track.** Ready to literally feel the horses thundering by? Catch a live race meeting and you're guaranteed to experience the action up close and personal at family-friendly Wyong Race Club.
- **Love Lanes Festival.** The quirky Love Lanes Festival takes place each February among the historic laneways and streets of Wyong CBD.
- **Adventure in the hinterland.** Take the kids to meet a friendly farm animal at Amazement Farm & Fun Park, pat some animals, ride a pony or climb through a canopy at Treetops Adventure.
