What to expect

New Years Eve Gosford event is a large event to showcases music, food and activities.

NYE Gosford is managed and produced by Central Coast Council.
The event is free.

When: Wednesday 31 December 2025

Where: Leagues Club Park, Baker Street, Gosford, NSW, 2250.

Times: 6pm – 9pm

Music and food

Music offers a wide range of performances by artists. The park is a place where you will be able to discover and enjoy music together.

There will be a variety of food and dessert stalls at the event. You will need to purchase food.

There will be big crowds surrounding the food areas. I will need extra time to move around and to buy food.



Crowds

There will be many people in Gosford Leagues Club Park for the event. It can get very crowded.

Hidden disability Sunflower Lanyard

NYE Gosford supports the Hidden Disability Sunflower. The lanyard is a way for me to indicate to event staff that I may need extra support, time and understanding.

If I would like to purchase my own Sunflower product, I can visit the Hidden Disabilities Sunflower website.

It is ok if I don't have a lanyard, I can still get help when I need it. Look out for Central Coast Council Event Staff wearing the 'Event Staff' shirts.



What else to bring?

NYE Gosford can be bright, busy, noisy and full of surprises – with large crowds, loud sounds, and weather that can change quickly.

To help me feel comfortable and ready for anything, I can bring things with me, and if I forgot something or need anything, I can also purchase items like food, drinks around the festival.

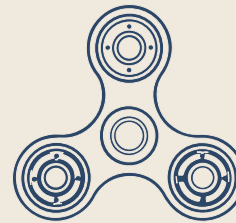

Noise cancelling headphones



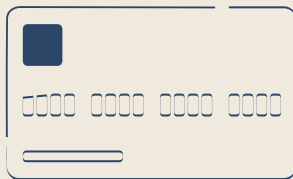
Water bottle



Sensory tools



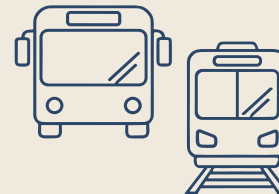
Phone or tablet

Driving and Road Closures

Some roads will be closed. I can't drive to vantage points or see the event from my car.

There will be lots of traffic on the roads that remain open so I should allow extra travel time, or I can catch public transport.

Road closures:

- **Georgiana Terrace**
Closed between Dane Drive and Baker street from 11am
- **Baker Street**
Closed between Georgiana Terrace and Vaughan Avenue from 6am
- **Vaughan Avenue**
Closed from 6am
- **Brian McGowan Bridge**
Closed for the duration of the fireworks (at the conclusion of the A-League match between 8.45-9.15pm)



Car Parking

Car parking close to the event will be busy. I might choose to leave my car at home and catch public transport.

If I choose to drive, roads might close while my car is parked. Cars aren't allowed to drive on closed roads or exit car parks on closed roads unless a Police Officer says it's okay.

I can bring my certifies assistance animal. They must be on a leash in all parts of the event site.

Safety

Nye Gosford has a First Aid tent located in Leagues Club Park. If I am feeling unwell or if I have hurt myself, I can find help at this tent.

Water re-fill stations

Water is available from water re-fill stations in Leagues Club Park.



What if its Raining?

NYE Gosford is an outdoors event. Please be prepared for all weather conditions and bring a raincoat, umbrella, or spray jacket.

Sensory Information

When I visit NYE Gosford, I might come across different sensory experiences. These include:

- Loud areas
- Fireworks
- Announcements that come across through speakers
- Music through speakers
- Flashing lights on the stage

Quiet Space

If the crowds, noise, fireworks or bright lights feel like too much, I can step into a quiet spaces. Staff will be there, ready to help, creating a calm and comfortable retreat where I can take a break and reset. The quiet spaces is located at the Rocking The Senses van in Leagues Club Park.



Who to ask for help

Event staff

Event staff can support me with wayfinding, directions and communication during the event. I can bring a support worker or companion if I require hands-on assistance such as wheelchair pushing, side by side support or trained assistance.

Event staff will be wearing navy blue shirts that say 'Event Staff' on the back.

Event Information Booth

At this booth, event staff will be able to provide event information and answer my questions. This will be a blue marquee in Leagues Club Park labelled 'Central Coast Council'.

There is an accessible viewing area located in Leagues Club Park, Gosford. I don't need to book seats for the accessible viewing areas. I can bring a blanket and get a front row view while taking a break from the crowd.
