■ **Browse Ettalong Beach's stylish seaside boutiques.** Visit Ettalong Beach for unique stores owned by local makers and creators. Discover beautiful homewares, gifts, and iconic outfits for every occasion.

■ **Indulge in lovingly made sweet treats.** Ettalong is filled with delicious artisan options for sweet-toothed folk. Try coffee with European-style crêpes or discover high tea by the sea.

■ **Sink into the local coffee culture.** Get your coffee fix at one of the local cafes oozing with character. Opt for a courtyard catch up or cozy indoor coffee, there's options to suit all vibes.

■ **Cycle The Esplanade and enjoy a scenic picnic.** Hire a bike from the local bike hire and follow the shared coastal pathway – The Esplanade – to the neighboring town of Umina Beach, and back.

■ **Meet The Peninsula's makers and creators.** Start with a visit to the gallery, where local artists' work and exhibitions are curated and sold by a dedicated cooperative group. Then browse the weekend markets for locally handmade fashion, homewares and hidden treasures.

■ **Learn to surf or SUP on calm waters.** Gentle swells at nearby Ocean Beach and Umina Beach create the perfect conditions for kids and adults to learn surfing and stand-up paddleboarding.

■ **Charming cinema and cocktail experience.** Travel back to yesteryear while watching the latest film at Ettalong Beach's vintage movie theatre, then indulge in a cocktail at a nearby bar.

■ **Coastal fine-dining.** From the taste of South America to the modern Australian cuisine, Ettalong Beach's variety of restaurants call for casual get-togethers or romantic seaside dates.
